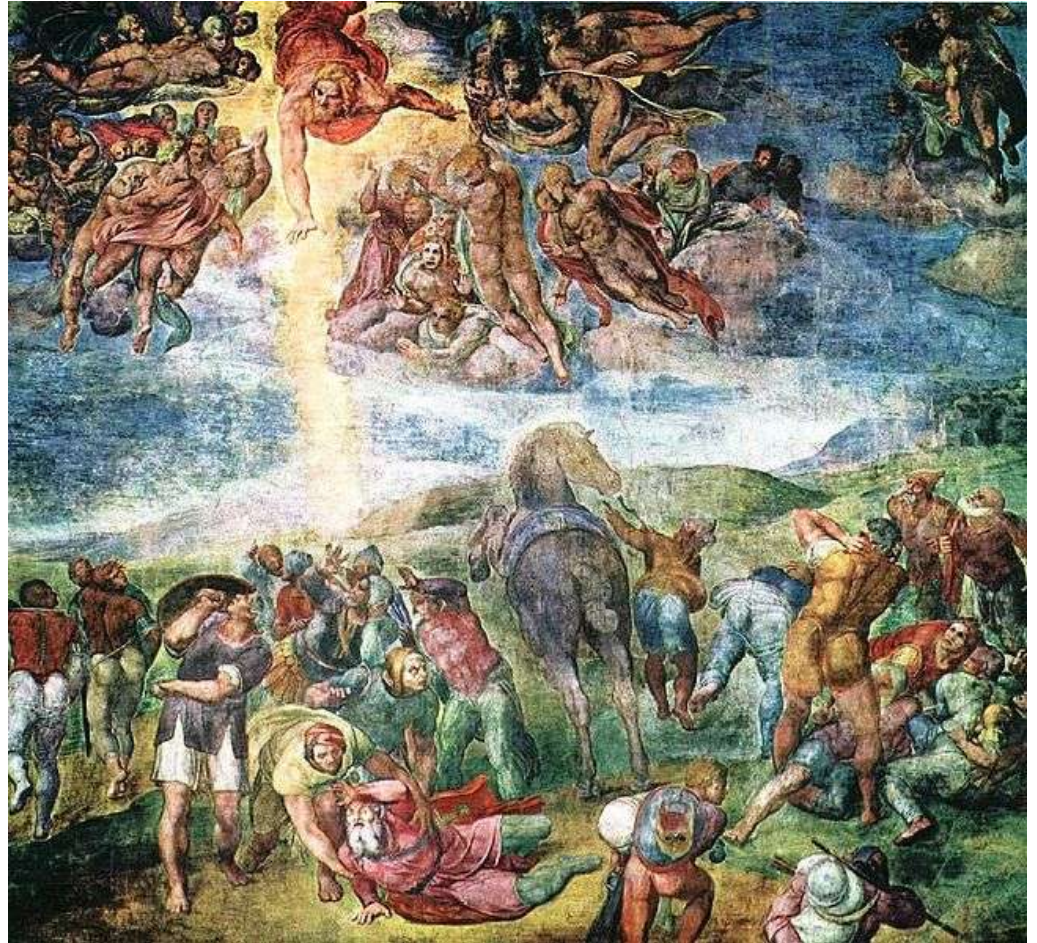
Feast of the Conversion of St. Paul the Apostle January 25, 2012

Paul's conversion can be dated to 31-36 by his reference to it in one of his letters. According to the Acts of the Apostles, his conversion took place on the road to Damascus where he claimed to have experienced a vision of the resurrected Jesus after which he was temporarily blinded.

Luke, the author of Acts of the Apostles, likely learned of his conversion from one of these three sources: Paul himself, from the church in Jerusalem, or from the church in Antioch.

Biblical Reflections

On Readings of Next Sunday
Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time
February 5th, 2012

Mark's Gospel for next week (Mark 1:29-39) opens with Jesus, along with James and John, entering the house of Simon and Andrew where Simon's mother-in-law lay very sick with a fever. With Jesus' touch the fever immediately leaves her. Then, later that same evening, Jesus continued his miraculous healing of many with various diseases as well as driving out demons, not permitting them to speak since they knew who He was.

Jesus often had the habit of rising very early before dawn and going to some deserted quiet place where He would pray. By staying close to His Father Jesus would then set out energized for another day of teaching and healing. All this gave the people hope that God was at work among them. However, Jesus realized that many were seeking Him out due to His miraculous powers. It is not until later that they will understand His entire life and mission. Mark's Jesus will ultimately reveal Himself as the true Messiah by being powerless by His own will on the cross sacrificing Himself completely for our sins. Christians must accept Jesus' way of suffering as the Messiah along with His awesome works of miracles. He has given us a real example of true humility
