## Our Mother of Perpetual Help

The earliest written prayer to Mary comes to us from an Egyptian manuscript from the third or fourth century. Marian apparitions were common in the church of Saint Gregory Nazianzen, a bishop of Constantinople who died in 390. He spoke in one of his sermons about a seemingly widely accepted practice of prayer being addressed to Mary. This tells us that in the late fourth century, Christians in some locales in the East didn't consider prayerful interaction with Mary to be strange or in need of a great deal of justification.

The practice of intercession, or asking Mary for favors, is evident from as early as the fifth century in noncanonical texts devoted to the death of Mary: Palm of the Tree of Life and the Six Books. Both contain accounts of people receiving miraculous help through their intercession of Mary.

# Biblical Reflections

On Readings of Next Sunday  
**7<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Easter**  
**May 20<sup>th</sup>, 2012**

The Gospel Reading for next week (John 17: 11b-19) is a prayer of Jesus. It is a prayer for His disciples and for us and reads as a conversation between Jesus and His Heavenly Father. As we read His prayer we understand that Jesus is full of concern for His friends from whom He knows that He will soon be parted because His time of Passion and Death is near.

To paraphrase, Jesus asks that His disciples be protected by the immense power of God, and that their unity with one another be based on the intimate union of Father and Son; that they be guarded from the evil one of this world; that they be truly consecrated, as is Jesus, in complete dedication to God's service, which will be a mission to the world; and that they will be one just as Jesus is one with the Father, and that the disciples' unity duplicate that between Father and Son.

Jesus, knowing that He will very soon be leaving His friends, thinks about all the trials and tribulations that will follow for them, while He also longs for them to share His joys. Jesus, of course, longs to protect them from such hardships but knows full well that to complete their work for God the hardships and sufferings are inevitable. All these thoughts and feelings are flooding upon Jesus as He prays. However, in spite of all that is about to come tumbling down on Him for the world's salvation, He prays all the harder for His disciples that they may remain strong and be "consecrated in truth." Through His words we witness the parallel between the mission that God gave to Jesus, and the one Jesus gave His disciples.

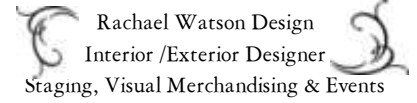
